NURSERY RHYME TIME:

OR

One named Quiet and the other named Loud

(say Quiet softly and say Loud with more force to represent Quiet & Loud)

TICKLE TIME:

Round and round the garden (circle baby's belly with fingers)
Goes the teddy bear (walk fingers around baby's belly button)
A one-step, a two-step (walk fingers from baby's belly button to chin)
A tickle under there!!! (tickle baby under chin)
